Course Description

The 1st Annual Charleston Urology Forum: Genitourinary Cancers and Survivorship provides a comprehensive and practical review of contemporary multidisciplinary management of genitourinary malignancies, including prostate, kidney, bladder, upper tract, penile, and testicular cancers.

As the field of genitourinary oncology continues to evolve rapidly, there is an increasing need for timely dissemination of new knowledge. This conference was developed to provide healthcare professional throughout MUSC Health system and across South Carolina with access to the latest advances, foster multidisciplinary collaboration, and promote the delivery of high-quality, patient-centered cancer care.

This program features expert presentations from MUSC faculty, and invited leaders in oncology, complemented by multidisciplinary tumor boards, case-based discussions, and interactive panel sessions.

Through these educational formats, participants will review current evidence, discuss challenging clinical scenarios, and explore emerging advances. Participants will gain practical knowledge that can be directly incorporated into the care of patients with genitourinary cancers.
